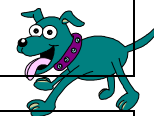

Agility Camp "Developing Your Team"

Wednesday will start at 1:00pm and end at 5:00 pm. There will be a welcoming BBQ at the end of the Wednesday session.

The other two days will consist of 6 hours of instruction beginning at 9:00 am. Breakfast and lunch will be provided each day.

The purpose of a NADAC Beginners Agility Test is to demonstrate the ability of the dog and handler to perform many of the basic tests to prepare them for a future agility career. The dog should be under control at all times and show a willingness to work with the handler. Dogs must be 12 months old the day of the test and have a current NADAC number

Cost \$5.00 per dog
